

Information and application form for contribution for dissertation

Contribution

Are you conducting research into cardiovascular diseases for a doctorate? Then you can apply to the Heart Foundation for a contribution for producing your dissertation. If your research is already being subsidised by the Heart Foundation, then our contribution amounts to €1,000,00. In all other cases the contribution is €500,00.

Terms and conditions

To be considered for this reimbursement, you must meet a number of conditions:

- The research described in your dissertation must have a **direct** connection to the fight against cardiovascular diseases.
- You must send a digital copy of your **definitive** dissertation to research@hartstichting.nl **at the latest 2 weeks** before your doctoral degree is awarded (date of defence). Please enclose the completed application form along with your dissertation.
The size of the thesis may not exceed 25MB. Use WeTransfer if the dissertation is too big for sending by e-mail.
- On the page listing the names of the members of your doctoral committee, please add: "Financial support by the Dutch Heart Foundation for the publication of this thesis is gratefully acknowledged".
- You may **not** give the name of an **industrial sponsor** in the same sentence.
- If your dissertation is based on a Heart Foundation project, then place the Heart Foundation logo on the page listing the names of the members of your doctoral committee. The logo is available on the website: www.hartstichting.nl/help-mee/gebruik-logo-hartstichting.
Please also add the following sentence to this page: "The research described in this thesis was supported by a grant of the Dutch Heart Foundation (DHF *grant number*)".
NB: you should also state that the publication of the dissertation itself was made possible by the Heart Foundation. So two citations in total.
If the university does not allow the placing of a logo, then just include the sentence in your dissertation.
- Have your dissertation internationally catalogued with an ISBN number, see www.isbn.nl.

The Heart Foundation is solely responsible for assessing whether you do indeed meet all the conditions and if we can see a direct relationship to cardiovascular diseases. We will only transfer the money from our donors to support the publication of your dissertation if you pass this assessment. **If your dissertation does not meet all the conditions, then you will not receive a contribution, even if you have cited the Heart Foundation in your dissertation.** We shall inform you of our intention by e-mail within 5 workdays after receipt of your dissertation.

Publicity surrounding the dissertation

The Heart Foundation can only invest in research thanks to donations from the public. That is why we would like to show them what your research is accomplishing. Often, we produce a press release at about the time of completion of your doctorate or when a scientific publication appears, naturally after agreeing this with you.

If the publication of your dissertation is leading to contact with the press, radio or television, we would greatly appreciate it if you would mention the contribution of the Heart Foundation.
